### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE INPUT FROM THE COMMUNITY REGARDING THE REDRAWING OF ELECTION DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

**TAKE NOTICE** that the City Council of the City of Bellflower will conduct a public hearing on Monday, October 11, 2021, at 7 p.m., per Elections Code Section 21607.1, at which the City Council will 1) receive a report from staff and consultants on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw City Council election district boundaries; 2) review the released 2020 Census Data and draft maps; and 3) conduct a public hearing to receive public input on district boundaries.

All interested persons are invited to attend said hearing and express opinions relating to this matter.

City Council Members may be physically present in the Council Chambers. However, because of Orders issued by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, the City is required to comply with physical distancing and occupancy limitations at City Hall. To ensure public participation, the City Council ordered that the meeting may be, in part, conducted virtually pursuant to Executive Order No. N-29-20. Accordingly, the public may provide public comment by emailing comments to [cclerk@bellflower.org](mailto:cclerk@bellflower.org) before the start of the meeting or telephonically during the meeting by participating via the Zoom website/app (<https://www.zoom.us/>) or by calling (669) 900-6833 (Zoom Meeting ID provided on the City Council Meeting Agenda).
